

Leia excelled at exploring unusual objects and surfaces. Clever and confident, she tackled the steps and slope of the sliding board and tried balancing on a wobbly plastic shell. She walked over grates, gravel, grass, and more, learning to accept textures beneath her paws. Future guide and service dogs need to be able to navigate their handlers safely over, under, or around obstacles that might



appear in their travels. Walking on different surfaces prepared Leia for encounters with other unusual underfootings she might one day face in her working life.

Puppies can be startled by stimuli like the noise of a vacuum, the rush of an electric fan, or the sight of a Halloween costume. During formal assessments, staff observed Leia's responses to new sights and sounds. Opening an umbrella in her path only made her more playful and curious. "Bring it on," she said!
